WHO WE ARE

querstadtein is an association for political education. Since 2013, we have been developing **city tours as political education formats** in which participants get to know Berlin beyond established perspectives: formerly homeless people show the neighbourhoods on whose streets they used to sleep. Since 2016, city guides from countries such as Syria, Iraq and Kenya have also been linking their own migration stories with the public space. Digital tours via app, online seminars, an audio walk and exhibitions round off the programme. Our aim is to sensitise society to issues of social and global inequality.

In ten years, **100,000 participants** have taken part in our educational programmes. The majority of these are schools, educational and research institutions, but also companies, public institutions, NGOs and tourist groups. querstadtein has received several awards for its work, including the **Deutschen Engagementpreis** (German Engagement Award). The local and international media regularly report on querstadtein. In addition, our city leaders speak at academic events as experts from the perspective of those affected.

In a new project, we are focussing on the topic of **Climate Migration**. We are developing educational formats that familiarise participants with the global impact of the climate crisis from the perspective of those affected. Three city tours from the perspective of those affected and an app are being developed and high-profile events implemented. The project is being funded by the Postcode Lottery until the end of 2024.

WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

We are currently seeking one or more individuals interested in developing city tours on the topic of Climate Migration. You will be supported by both our team and a research assistant who will provide background information for the individual tours. Your responsibilities will include:

- Assisting the future tour guide in working out their own migration experience.
- Helping the future tour guide understand how their life path, as well as that of their family and community in their home country, has changed due to climate-related changes.
- Contributing to the development of background information on the impacts of climate change at the origin of the affected person and resulting migration movements.
- Researching information about locations in the city of Berlin.
- Collaborating with the future city guide to curate the city tour, connecting locations in the city with background information about the guide's biography and place of origin, as well as information about climate.
- Additionally, you will empower the guide through coaching offers from our side and assist them in practicing and rehearsing the tour.



WHAT WE WISH FOR

- (First) experience working with affected people, possessing empathy and sensitivity in dealing with people who have experiences with migration or similar challenges.
- Interest in the topics of climate and migration, ideally with relevant background knowledge and a willingness to further educate yourself.
- Preferably, skills in storytelling and a good sense of what makes an engaging city tour.
- Flexibility and the ability to commit to regular meetings over a period of at least six months.

WHAT WE OFFER

- Comprehensive onboarding, including the opportunity to get to know our previous city tours.
- Close collaboration with our team during the tour development.
- You will get to know interesting people and work on a socially and politically highly relevant topic.
- The opportunity to contribute your own ideas and themes and to be involved with querstadtein.
- Fair compensation on a freelance basis or as an honorary expense allowance.
