Since 2013, querstadtein has been organizing city tours on the topics of homelessness and migration. Our tour guides share their own perspectives within Berlin's urban space and provide information about structural social injustices. In doing so, they raise awareness, highlight structural inequality, and promote empathy and solidarity. Participants in our tours include educational institutions such as schools and universities, public institutions, NGOs, companies, and private individuals.

Have you couch-surfed with friends for an extended period of time? Have you lived in a garden allotment, a car, or a hostel? Were you no longer able to afford your apartment or room, or did you have to leave due to termination for personal use (“Eigenbedarf” eviction)?

Then get in touch with us! For our city tours, we are looking for **people who would like to inform others about precarious housing conditions and injustices in the Berlin housing market — and who have personal experience with these issues.**

- Together with us, you will develop your own political city tour.
- You will show places where fundamental questions about the distribution of housing, resources, and social coexistence can be discussed.
- You will share your personal experiences.
- You will answer participants' questions.

- You enjoy meeting new people.
- You are reliable and punctual.

What We Offer

- You will receive fair compensation (in the form of an “Übungsleiterpauschale”/instructor's allowance) or a mini-job for your work.
- We provide training and coaching. You will gain experience as a political educator.
- You will meet interesting people and organizations and build new connections.
- You can work flexibly; we coordinate tour dates with you.
- You can contribute your own ideas and topics.
- Upon request, you will receive a certificate recognizing your civic engagement.
