Responsibilities

The purpose of these tours is to raise awareness on the topics related to migration and climate change through firsthand lived experiences of individuals. You are free to choose the topics you want to talk about on your tour. Some examples of the related topics are:

- Reasons behind your migration that are related to the local or global climate change.
- Places in Berlin that you can relate to, especially in regard of your migration story.
- causes and effects of climate crisis that affect the situation in your hometown or country
- Your current life in Berlin, what you like and dislike about it, and the consequences of migration on your life.
- and other themes that you can relate to and are relevant to the climate-migration, such as the role that west world plays in the global climate change, refugee rights and life conditions in the destination country, and your daily struggles and challenges in Berlin.
- Answering questions of tour participants

Requirements

- You speak English (or German) at Level B1 or higher.
- You are interested in political education and willing to speak about the mentioned topics with German or international groups and talk about your own personal story.
- You have basic knowledge on the topic of climate change or are interested to learn about it.
- You can invest a few hours weekly in the project.
- You are open and interested in meeting new people.
- You are reliable and punctual.
- Certificate of Good Conduct.
